



July Rally 2008

The first Rally this year is being hosted by the Nottingham Society of Model and Experimental Engineers at Ruddington on Saturday 5th July and on the Sunday Polly Owners will be welcome to join in with the society's scheduled running day.

NSMEE will provide driving trollies that suit their track.

You will of course require the usual test certificates (hydraulic and steam) if you wish to steam up.

Spark arrestors are obligatory.

Non runners – fully or part built are most welcome.

The NSMEE track is within Rushcliffe Country Park which also includes the Nottingham Transport Heritage Centre and the GCR (Nottingham) so there is plenty to see apart from admiring each others Pollies. On the Sunday there is a Volvo Rally!

As well as the Country Park other attractions in the vicinity are Ruddington Village Museum and a museum dedicated to frame knitting!

Getting there –

Ruddington is 3 miles south of Nottingham City Centre just off the A52 ring road and the main A60 road (via the small roundabout at Ruddington) and 7 miles north of Loughborough. The Heritage Centre is sign posted (brown signs) in both directions on the A60.
